
If you suspect your pet has ingested any of these items, please call your family veterinarian, AES, or poison control right away!

- Human Medications (Advil, Tylenol, etc.)

- Fertilizers & Pesticides
- Slug/Snail Bait
- Rat/Mouse/Mole Poison
