



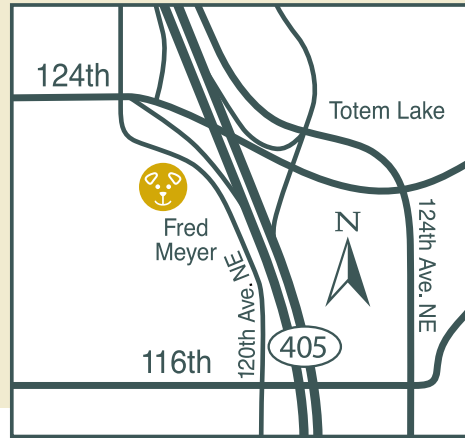
## Watch Out for Common Household Toxins!

- Wild Mushrooms
- Sugarless Gum, Candy & Toothpaste (due to Xylitol)
- Human Medications (Advil, Tylenol, etc.)
- Alcohol
- Coffee
- Nicotine
- Cleaning Products
- Antifreeze
- Fertilizers & Pesticides
- Slug/Snail Bait
- Rat/Mouse/Mole Poison

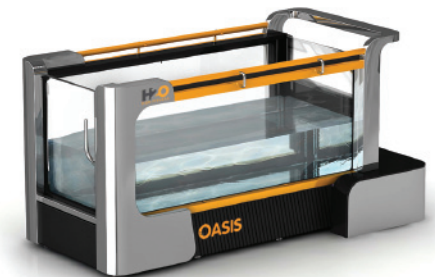
- Our new hospital is equipped with cutting-edge patient monitoring equipment to make sure your pet stays comfortable before, during, and after surgery.
