If you suspect your pet has ingested any of the following, please call AES, your family veterinarian, or poison control right away!

- Human medications – NSAIDs, anti-depressants, acetaminophen, ADD/ADHD drugs, etc.
- Fruits and vegetables – grapes, raisins, currants, onions, garlic, chives, avocado, etc.
- Xylitol – sugarless gum, candy, toothpaste, baked goods, peanut butter, etc.
- Flowers and plants – lilies, foxgloves, sago palm, wild mushrooms, etc.
- Garage items – cleaning products, antifreeze, fertilizers, pesticides, etc.
- Caffeine and nicotine products
- Mold and moldy foods
- Chocolate
- Marijuana
- Unbaked dough



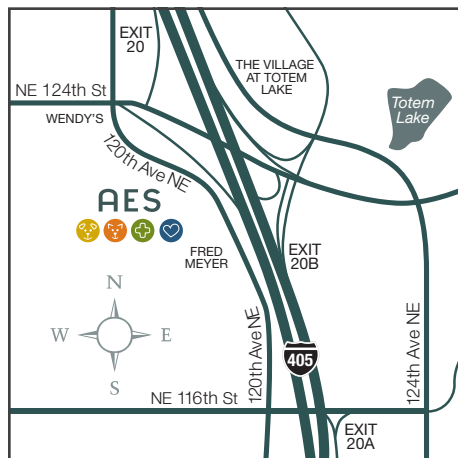

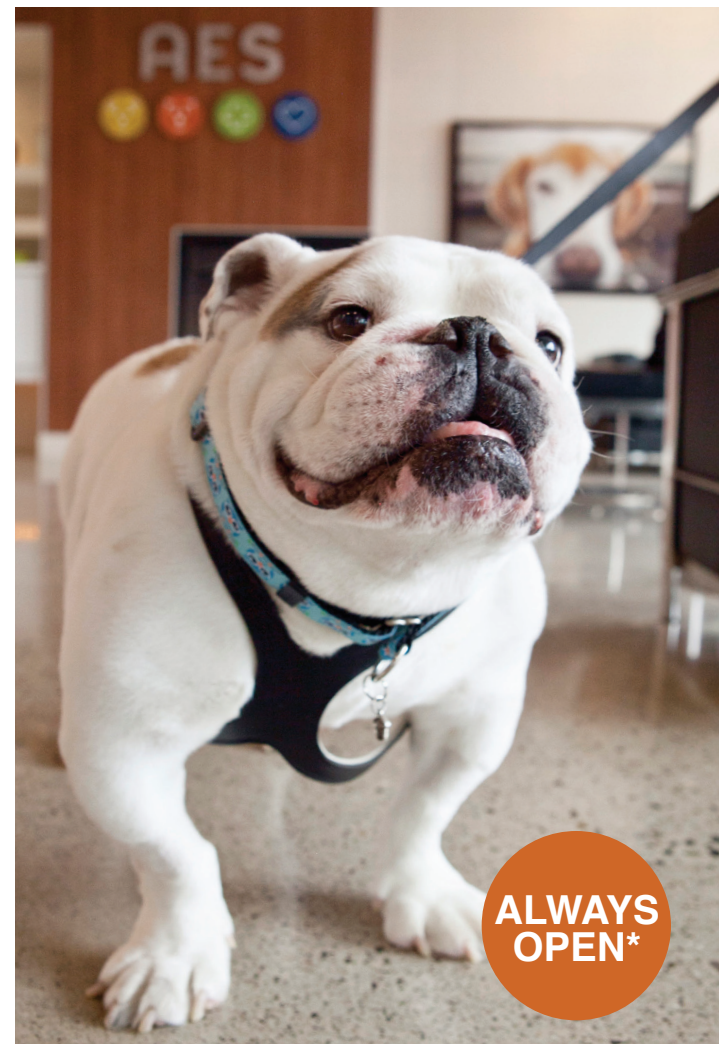

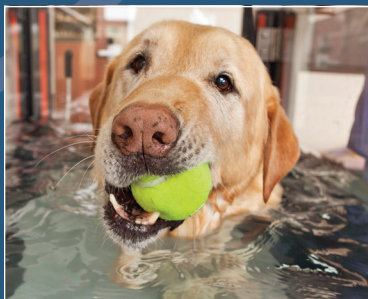
